Road Traffic Speed Limits County of Fingal Bye-Laws Local and Regional Roads 2016 No. 1

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004) hereby makes the following Bye-Laws in respect of certain regional and local roads within the administrative County of Fingal.

- 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws Local and regional roads 2016 No.1.
- 2. These Bye-Laws shall come into operation on the 16th day of May 2016.
- 3. In these Bye-Laws:-

"the Act of 1993" means the Roads Act, 1993 (Number 14 of 1993);

"the Act of 2004" means the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004);

"built-up area" has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 2004;

"distance" means distance measured along the centreline of a road;

"the Minister" means the Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport;

"national road" has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

"regional road" has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

"local road" has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

"motorway" has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

"road" means a public road and includes a motorway;

"perimeter road" means a road on and along the roadway of which there runs the boundary of an administrative county or city and shall be considered as being within such boundary for the purposes of these Bye-Laws.

- i. The following special speed limits shall be the speed limits for mechanically propelled vehicles on the roads where referred to in these byelaws, Thirty (30) kilometres per hour.

The provisions of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws 2002, the Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) (Amendment No.1 Bye-Laws 2004, the Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws 2006, the Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws No.1 2007, the Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws No.2 2007, Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws No.2 2007, Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws No.2 2007, Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws (No. 1) 2012, Road Traffic Speed Limits County of Fingal Bye-Laws Local and Regional Roads 2014, Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws (No. 1 and 2) 2015 insofar as they apply to any of the roads or parts thereof referred to in the schedules to these Bye-Laws are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the said roads or parts thereof with effect from the date on which these bye-laws come into effect.
