Enjoying and Protecting Howth's Unique Landscape



What is the Howth S.A.A.O.?

As a resident of the Howth Peninsula you know it is a beautiful place, with a varied landscape, wildlife habitats and many recreational opportunities.

Because of Howth's location in close proximity to a capital city, it became apparent to many in the 1990s that some of the much-valued assets of the area needed protection and enhancement alongside development.

In 1999 the Minister for the Environment signed the **Special Amenity Area Order (S.A.A.O.)** for Howth. This order sets out a framework for the **conservation** and **protection** of the area designated in accordance with the Planning Act and Planning Regulations. The Howth Special Amenity Area covers a total of 547 hectares. It includes **Ireland's Eye** (28 hectares) as well as heathland, woods, cliffs and wooded residential areas of the south-eastern half of the peninsula (519 hectares).



Who manages the Howth S.A.A.O.?

The Howth S.A.A.O. Management Committee manages the area and includes community groups, landowners and local elected councillors as well as experts in wildlife and heathland management.

The Committee's work is ongoing with a lot of work undertaken by voluntary groups in conjunction with Fingal County Council.

These works include:

- *Maintenance and repair of paths and the provision of directional signage*
- *Grassland and Heathland management including the removal of Rhododendron from heathland areas as well as plant survey work*
- *Protection of wildlife including the Red Squirrel Conservation Project*
- *Input into the planning process to protect the landscape, views & prospects as set out in the S.A.A.O.*
- *Protection of historical sites*

Background Legislation

European Legislation and Wildlife Protection

Parts of the Howth peninsula are designated as a Special Protection Area (SPA) and as a Special Area of Conservation (SAC).

Special Areas of Conservation (SACs) are set out under the European Habitats Directive, to protect wildlife and the places where they live.

Special Protection Areas (SPAs) are concerned with the long-term protection of wild bird species and their habitats, as set out in the European Birds Directive.



SACs and SPAs form a European wide network of sites known as Natura 2000 sites which Fingal County Council is obliged by law to ensure are protected and conserved.

The primary responsibility for the above legislation lies with the **National Parks and Wildlife Service (N.P.W.S.)** within the Department of Arts, Heritage and the Gaeltacht.

What does the S.A.A.O. mean for you?

Planning and development:

It is a requirement of the S.A.A.O. to enhance and protect the attractive and distinctive landscape character of the Howth.

Common issues considered when development proposals are assessed by Fingal County Council include siting and design of proposed development, site planting, site boundaries, design of boundary walls and design of entrances.

For planning guidance, it is recommended that the **Howth/ Malahide Area Planner** is consulted prior to a planning application being lodged in the area of the S.A.A.O.

Garden Waste:

The disposal of garden waste within the confines of an existing garden is appropriate. Where cut garden waste is disposed of within the protected landscape /pathways /cliffs, this can result in the unwanted introduction of **invasive garden plants and the loss of protected native plants and habitats within this special landscape.**

Céard é O.L.T.S. Bhinn Éadair?

Mar chónaitheoir i Leithinis Bhinn Éadair, is eol duit gurb áit álainn í ina bhfuil éagsúlacht tírdhreacha, gnáthóga fiadhúlra agus cuid mhór deiseanna áineasa ar fáil.

De bharr shuíomh Bhinn Éadair, atá suite an-ghar do phríomhchathair, d'éirigh sé soiléir do chuid mhór daoine le linn bhlianta na 1990idí gur ghá sócmhainní an-luachmhar an limistéir a chosaint agus a fheabhsú le linn iad a bheith á bhforbairt.

Sa bhliain 1999, shínigh an tAire Comhshaoil **an tOrdú um Limistéar Taitneamhachta Speisialta (O.L.T.S.)** do Bhinn Éadair. San ordú sin, leagtar amach creat i gcomhair **chaomhnú** agus **chosaint** an limistéir atá ainmnithe de réir an Achta Pleanála agus na Rialachán Pleanála.

Tá achar iomlán 547 heicteár ann i Limistéar Taitneamhachta Speisialta Bhinn Éadair. Tá **Inis Mac Neasáin** ann (28 heicteár), chomh maith le fraochmhánna, coillte, aillte agus limistéir chónaitheacha faoi chrainn i ndeisceart na leithinse (519 heicteár).



Coiste Bainistíochta O.L.T.S. Bhinn Éadair

Is é Coiste Bainistíochta O.L.T.S. Bhinn Éadair a bhainistíonn an limistéar agus cuimsíonn an coiste sin grúpaí pobail, úinéirí talún agus comhairleoirí tofa áitiúla, chomh maith le saineolaithe sa réimse bainistíochta fiadhúlra agus fraochmhánna. Tá an Coiste ag obair ar bhonn leanúnach agus tá cuid mhór oibre déanta ag grúpaí deonacha i gcomhar le Comhairle Contae Fhine Gall.

Reachtaíocht Eorpach agus Cosaint Fiadhúlra

Tá codanna de leithinis Bhinn Éadair ainmnithe mar Limistéar faoi Chosaint Speisialta (LfCS) agus mar Limistéar Caomhantais Speisialta (LCS).

Tá **Limistéir Chaomhantais Speisialta** (LCS-anna) leagtha amach faoi Threoir na hEorpa maidir le Gnáthóga chun an fiadhúlra agus na háiteanna ina bhfuil fiadhúlra a chosaint.

Baineann **Limistéir faoi Chosaint Speisialta** (LfCS-anna) le cosaint fhadtéarmach speiceas éan fiáin agus a gcuid gnáthóg de réir mar atá leagtha amach i dTreoir na hEorpa maidir le hÉin.



Is iad na LCS-anna agus na LfCS-anna na heilimintí atá ann i ngréasán uile-Eorpach ar a dtugtar Láithreáin Natura 2000 agus, de réir oibleagáide dlíthiúla, ní mór do Chomhairle Contae Fhine Gall a chinntiú go ndéantar iad a chosaint agus a chaomhnú.

Tá an fhreagracht fhoriomlán as an reachtaíocht thuas ar an tSeirbhís **Páirceanna Náisiúnta agus Fiadhúlra (S.P.N.F.)** laistigh den Roinn Ealaíon, Oidhreachta agus Gaeltachta.
