



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STOCKHOLE LANE, SWORDS, CO. DUBLIN

An application has been received for the temporary closure of Stockhole Lane (L2051), between the R139 and Baskin Lane.

The purpose of this closure is for the installation of a 200mm diameter aviation fuel line.

The period of the proposed temporary closure will be from **8.00am Monday, 24th February 2020 until 6.00pm Monday, 1st June 2020.**

The alternative route for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure is as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
Northbound	Dublin Airport	R139 Clonsaugh Road - R107 Malahide Road - Baskin Lane
Southbound	M50 (Clayton Hotel)	Baskin Lane - R107 Malahide Road - R139 Clonsaugh Road

Local access will be maintained over the proposed period of closure.
