



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAUDERS LANE, SUTTON, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Lauders Lane, Sutton, Co. Dublin**, following an application from John Cradock Ltd on behalf of Irish Water.

The purpose of this closure is for the installation of a subterranean watermain at the railway crossing with ancillary works at Lauders Lane/Burrow Road Junction.

The period of the temporary closure will be from **08.00 Monday, 22nd February 2021 until 18.00 Friday, 19th March 2021**.

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative route for traffic travelling in the area during the closure is as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
Station Road to Burrow Road	Burrow Road	Sutton Cross to Howth Road. Cross Railway Line at Claremont Road onto Burrow Road
Burrow Road to Station Road	Station Road	Cross the Railway Line at Claremont Road to Howth Road and to Station Road via Sutton Cross

Local access will be provided over the period of the closure.
