



ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 – SECTION 75

NOTICE OF THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF WINDGATE ROAD, HOWTH, CO. DUBLIN.

Fingal County Council has made an order to temporarily close a section of **Windgate Road, Howth, Co. Dublin**, following an application from New Century Engineering on behalf of ESB Networks.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the the installation of Underground Ducting. The road will be closed between **its junction with Greenhollows Quarries and Windgate Rise**, over two periods, as follows:

- **08.00 Monday, 20th September 2021 until 18.00 Friday, 24th September 2021**
- **08.00 Monday, 27th September 2021 until 18.00 Tuesday, 28th September 2021**

No submissions were received during the consultation process.

The alternative routes for traffic travelling in the area during the proposed closure are as follows:

Direction of Travel	Destination	Alternative Routes
From Greenhollows Quarries Junction (on Windgate Road)	Junction of Windgate Rise and Windgate Road	Windgate Road to Balkill Road to Windgate Rise and onto Windgate Road
From Windgate Rise Junction (with Windgate Road)	Junction of Greenhollows Quarries and Windgate Road	Windgate Rise to Balkill Road and onto Windgate Road

Local access will be provided over the period of the proposed closure.
