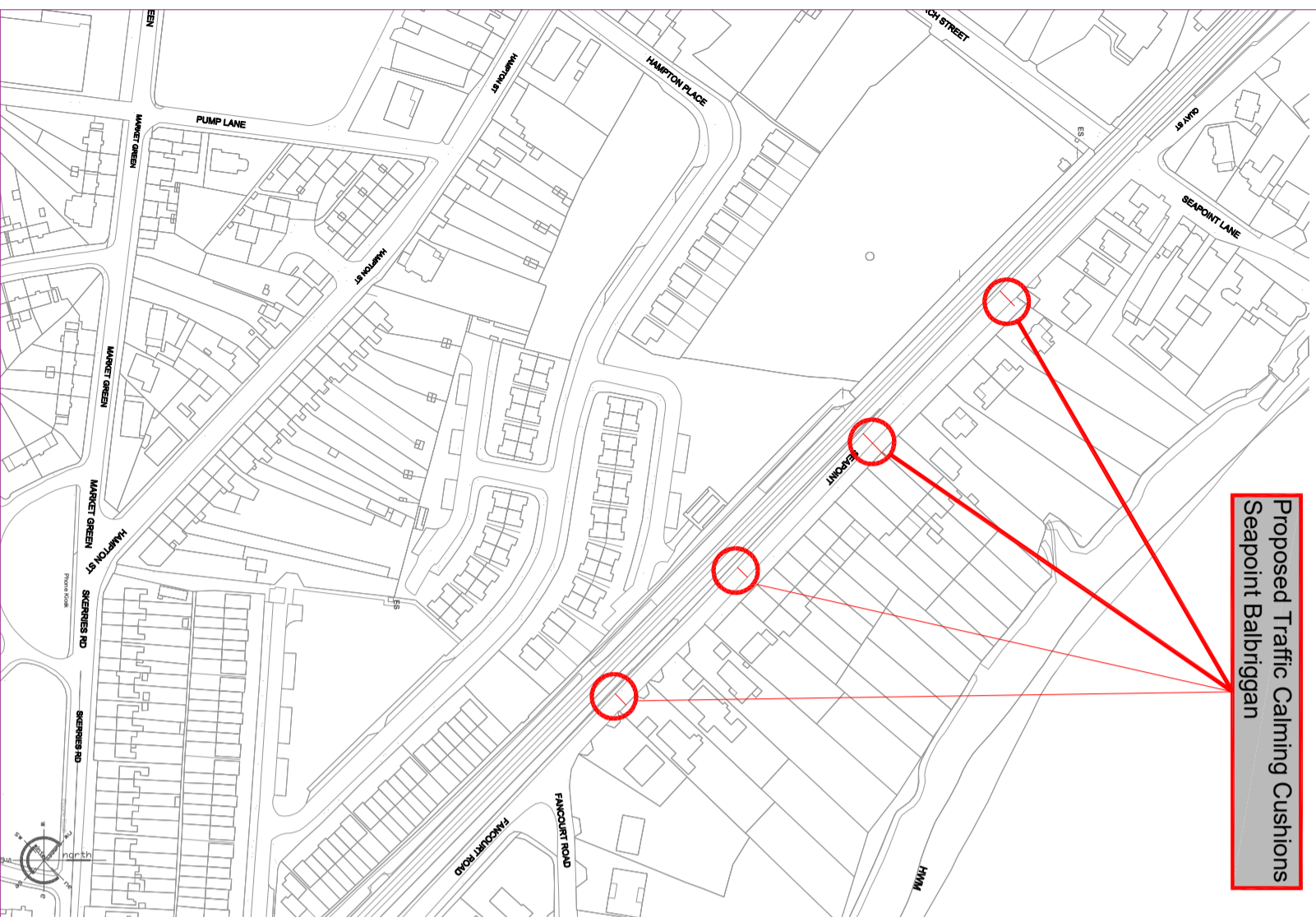
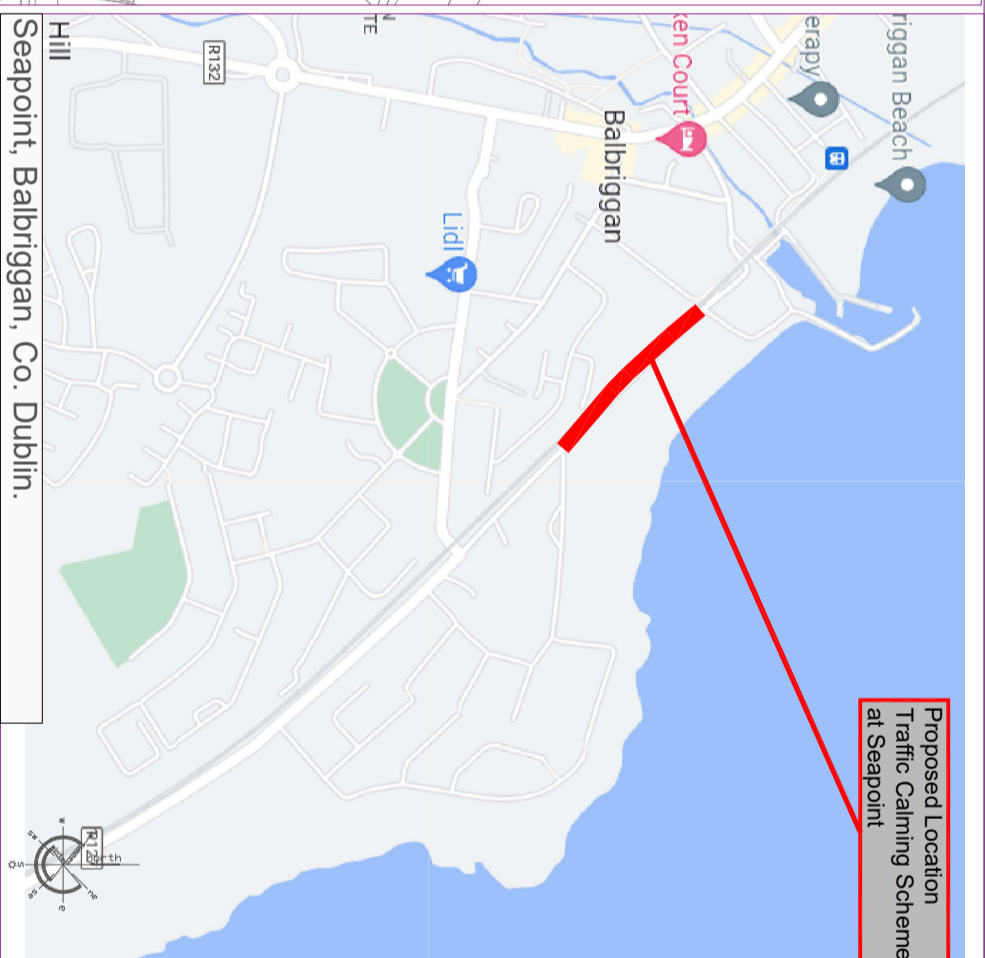


**Proposed Traffic Calming Cushions**  
Seapoint Balbriggan

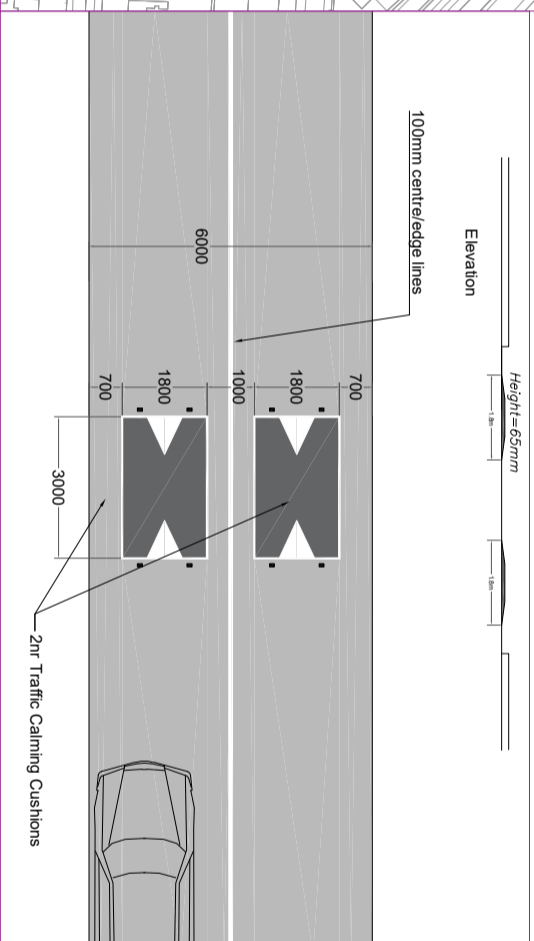


**Proposed Location**

TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES  
Balbriggan / Rush / Lusk / Swords Operational Area

- Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared Schemes for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:
- Beverton Meadows, Donabate, Co Dublin. - 1 No. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramp.
  - Jugback Lane, Swords, Co. Dublin. - 4 No. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
  - Rivermeade Drive, Toberburry, St. Margaret's, Co. Dublin. - 2 No. Flat Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
  - Main Street, Garristown, Co. Dublin. - 1 No. Bus Friendly Ramp with Zebra Crossing Road Markings.
  - Seapoint, Balbriggan, Co. Dublin. - 4 No. Sets Modular Traffic Calming Cushions.

The schemes provide for traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary. Plans and particulars of the Schemes as shown on Drawing Numbers: 2024-PD-TC-BRLS-001 to 2024-PD-TC-BRLS-005, are available for inspection from Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024.

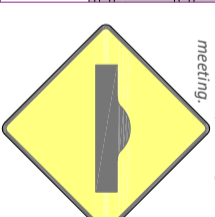
